- Respect Each Voice- Everyone on the task force is committed to climate action and brings diverse perspectives on achieving goals. There is strength in the depth and breadth of knowledge across the taskforce. - Respect Consensus- For the task force's duration, we will be working toward consensus and honoring dissent. The consultants and the *City* will limit comments to the media about the task force's work until the task force has completed a draft document for public comment. Members should do the same. By allowing the focus to be on process, time is afforded this group to explore and achieve common ground as the plan's substance comes together over time.
- Respect Engagement and Transparency- NMF will share notes from each meeting with participants and the City. NMF and the City are committed to creating time for public comment toward the end of issue meetings. Time will be limited to accommodate as many voices as possible within time limits. If comments are unrelated to climate action, the time will be passed to the next person in the zoom public gallery section. People may also provide comments through a taskforce e-mail that is monitored and documented by NMF staff.
