Summary	Recommendation
<p>1. Adjust school policy to allow cell phone use in class to access internet.</p>	<p>So that students can use cell phones to access information quickly on the internet to improve grades and interest in school subjects, adjust school policy and allow students to show they can be trusted to use technology in a positive way and demonstrate student performance to the faculty.</p>
<p>2. Allow use of cell phones and cameras for security reasons.</p>	<p>So that students and their parents feel more comfortable and safe during school hours in an unpredictable world, allow use of cell phones and cameras during school hours so that students have instant access to the outside world.</p>
<p>3. Allow use of iPods to help concentration and share school notes.</p>	<p>So that students can concentrate better and share information with students who miss school or have difficulty organizing their materials, allow use of iPods at school to listen to music while doing their school work and program notes and ideas which can be shared with other students.</p>
