Summary	Recommendation
1. Hold weekly round table discussions.	So that students have a more of a voice, hold a weekly roundtable during lunch with school administrators to discuss issues and ideas related to the student body.
2. Construct an activities bill board.	So that students learn more about school activities, construct a large billboard to hang in the quad, gym, and cafeteria that will announce all school events that involve students.
3. Set up a mass text message system.	So that students learn more about school activities, set up a mass text message system which students can sign up to receive information about school events.
4. Start school earlier.	So that more students can participate in school activities, start school earlier allowing students to get home or to work earlier and give them time to participate in school activities.
5. Provide more transportation options.	So that more students can participate in school activities, provide more transportation at more frequent times (i.e., an earlier bus than 6:30) which would multiply the number of students who could participate in activities.
