Summary	Recommendation
1. Establish a school clean-up club.	So that our new school facilities are well maintained and students have an opportunity for a service learning activity, establish a campus club in which students can volunteer to pick up trash, clean campus buildings, and care for landscaping once or twice a month. If enough volunteers complete the clean-up activities each month, all students would be rewarded with an hour lunch.
2. Allow an option for school suspension.	So that there are consequences for littering, school administrators should require the school suspension group (RTC class) to volunteer services to keep our campus well maintained. Students who have to spend time in suspension could choose this option in exchange for less suspension time.
