Under-Aged Drinking Prevention	
Summary	Recommendation
1. Implement prevention classes.	So that young people learn the consequences of under-age drinking, school administrators should implement a prevention curriculum in the classroom, K-12.
2. Support community service projects.	So that young people have better alternative activities, the community should support community service learning projects, such as beautification projects.
3. Fund student-driven programs.	So that young people can make better decisions, student-driven programs such as S.A.D.D. (Students Against Drunk Driving) should be funded.
4. Support alternative activities.	So that young people have more productive options for after school activity, the community should sponsor drug-free activities for youth such as games, dances, ropes courses, etc.
